


1972-2012: 40 Years of Limits to Growth

- Controversial when launched, generated global headlines, sold millions of copies
- Routinely attacked, on false grounds, for nearly 40 years
- Now widely acknowledged as an accurate analysis even by former critics (e.g. Joseph Stiglitz)





The "Great Acceleration": Growth is the defining feature of our era




Growth of human activity (global scale) 1750-2000

The Growth Dilemma

Deeply rooted conflicts, global to local level:

- Clash of goals (environmental sustainability v. human prosperity and well being)
- Clash of **beliefs** ("Resources are finite" v. "Innovation always finds substitutes")
- Clash of **world views** ("Nature is fragile" v. "Humans are supreme")



Why has growth continued, despite incredible advances in efficiency and productivity?

Answer: The so-called "Rebound Effect"

The more efficient we get, the more we can consume so we do.

(Also known as the Jevons Paradox, from William Stanley Jevons, *The Coal Question*, 1865)

Emerging patterns in the "Life Beyond Growth" global dialogue



I. "Green Growth" is emerging as the new mainstream



 Policy makers are sometimes using the phrase Green Growth in place of growth ... and also in place of sustainable development

 GG does not mean exactly the same thing as SD, but it **fills the same space** in policy discourse — this makes SD people worried



2. "Green Economy" is better than "Green Growth"



 "Green Economy" includes ecological limits and human well being more explicitly than GG

 But the concepts are bound up with their champions — each with an ideological "charge" (GE with UNEP and the NGOs, GG with McKinsey and World Economic Forum)




3. "Green Economy" + "Gross National Happiness" = Sustainable World

 These concepts are increasingly well defined, in scientific terms, with robust metrics

 Taken together, they could provide the world with the first new, comprehensive, common political-economic goal since the establishment of peace after WWII







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
